Pathways

This qualification may provide a pathway to higher education including post graduate studies or other qualifications relevant to their role in emergency management

Delivery platforms

Flexible delivery options are provided to support the learning and enable people to study at their own pace.

This program is designed to be delivered over 20 months with assistance to fast track if required. The program is open to both individuals and organisations-across Australasia using a number of platforms including workshops, eLearning, RPL, or a blended delivery format. Our interactive program offers opportunities to apply new skills in a practical hands-on way and support the ongoing professionalisation of those working in these critical community roles.

Assessment methods

We combine a range of assessment methods including workplace tasks, demonstrations, role-play, written reports, exercise design and conduct activities, case study reviews and project work.

Entry requirements

There are no specified entry requirements for this qualification however this program is aimed at leaders and a brief pre-entry assessment is required. It is preferred the learner has experience in the emergency management field as a paid professional or volunteer.

Fast track options

Applicants can apply for full or partial recognition (RPL) of their existing skills and knowledge relevant to the units of competence within the qualification. These may have been obtained through workplace training or experience and may reduce the number of units required to be completed. Contact ACIM Solutions to apply for a free RPL assessment.

Qualification and skill sets
